

# TransPAC Network AUP

TransPAC is an Indiana University led collaboration with the Asia Pacific Advanced Network (APAN), GEANT, the Pacific Northwest Gigapop, and many others. It's primary goal is to support the use of high speed international network services between Asia and the United States.

TransPAC is a transit network and therefore has no end users directly connected. Access to TransPAC is via connected networks, peers, and partners. Data communication over the TransPAC network is governed by the acceptable use policies of the campus, service provider, or other end networks involved in the traffic. TransPAC will offer settlement free peering to any Research and Education entity who can acquire a cross connect to one of our points of presence. TransPAC will not peer with any purely commercial entity.
